Minutes from meeting on February 2, 2010

Boosters President Mark Cavano opened the meeting

A motion was made to accept the January minutes, seconded, and approved.

Treasurer's Report

Mark Cavano read the treasurer's report. Income for January was \$1,278.81, including concession sales and a few more collections from the dine around. Expenses totaled \$4,980.60. The three \$1,000 scholarships from last year were paid in January. So, the net total for January was (3,700.79).

Financial Summary

Mark prepared a financial summary of projected income for the year. Once our fundraisers are completed, the Boosters expect to bring in approximately \$83,960.00. The expenses not related to the fundraising events are projected to be approximately \$12,503.00. The net income for the year, then, totals \$71,457.00, which is about \$3,500 short of our \$75,000 commitment.

In order to meet our commitment, our plan is to maximize earning potential at the Men's Night Out and Golf Tournament fundraisers. We are also looking to add 2 Clipper Fun Nights in April and assign a Car Wash/Bake Sale to one of the spring teams.

We discussed the Clipper Fun Nights and noted it was difficult to find parent volunteers to attend the events. Rather than assign the Clipper Fun Nights to specific teams, we decided to have parent sign up sheets at the spring fee collection in the cafeteria. That way, parents from all the teams have the opportunity to get involved, and can select the day that works best for them in April.
