

Morning Drop-Off and Afternoon Pick-Up Procedures and Helpful Tips



Morning Drop-Off Information and Procedures

- ❑ Parents can drop-off students as early as 7:00 AM as there is supervision by NMS staff in the cafetorium beginning at 7:00 AM
- ❑ Students need to be in their homeroom by 7:25; traffic has been heaviest at 7:20.
- ❑ Dropping students off earlier is recommended.
- ❑ When traffic is heavy, cars should pull as far forward as possible around the curve to the end of the canopy (closer to the Sparrell building). Students do not need to be dropped off right in front of the door.
- ❑ No car should park in the drop-off lane nor should a driver leave their car. If a student needs help carrying items into the school or the driver needs to exit the car, the car should be parked in the designated lot.

Afternoon Pick-Up Information and Procedures

- ☐ The school day ends at 1:58 PM. By nature of their schedule and location in the building, sixth grade students tend to leave the building first and seventh and eighth graders whose lockers are upstairs tend to leave the building a little later.
- ☐ Students exit from the front door or the cafetorium. Parents do not need to come into the building to pick-up their children after 1:58; students may exit the building for their ride.
- ☐ You do not need to pick-up your student right at 2:00. In the past, traffic has been heaviest between 1:50 - 2:10. If you can pick-up between 2:10 and 2:15, your entry and exit from the school parking lot will likely be quicker and you will contribute to less traffic.
- ☐ If arriving before 1:58, please follow traffic patterns and pull as far forward as possible to accommodate more cars.

Additional Information

- ☐ As always, please drive slowly and cautiously. Be aware of students crossing the road to the parking lot areas.
- ☐ Be careful entering the school driveway from Main Street as cars leaving and turning left are in a left turn lane in the middle of the driveway.
- ☐ Drop-off and pick-up in front of the Sparrell building and on Main Street are not allowed.
