### Curricula Grades 9-12



Norwell Public Schools' grades 9-12 English curricula follow the standards for English Language Arts content, which includes standards for reading, writing, speaking and listening, and language from the 2017 English Language Arts and Literacy Framework. All courses 9-12 meet or exceed the standards presented in these Frameworks. While the Frameworks do not prescribe a set reading list for all students, the English curricula is designed so that students are exposed to a wide variety of types of texts, including texts of high literary merit and significance.
