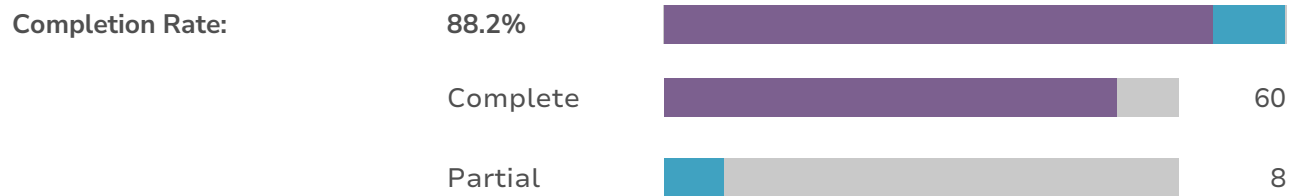


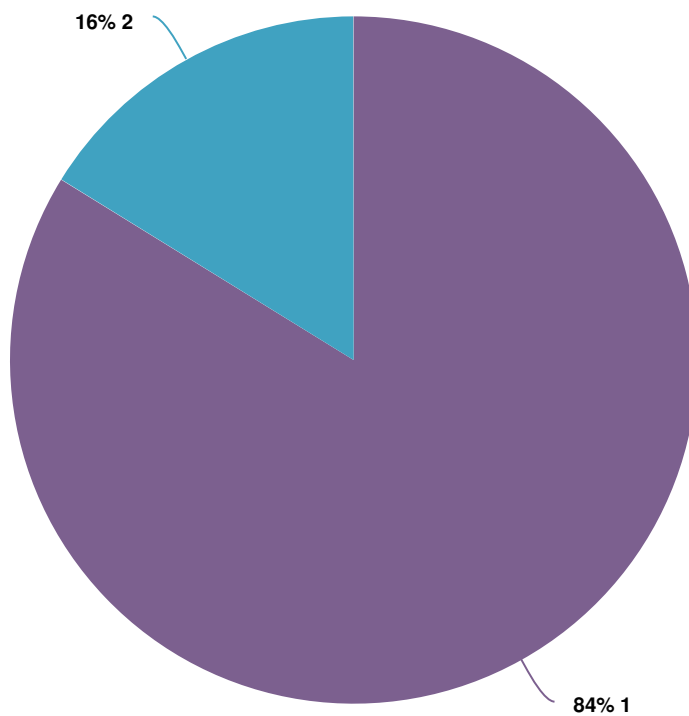

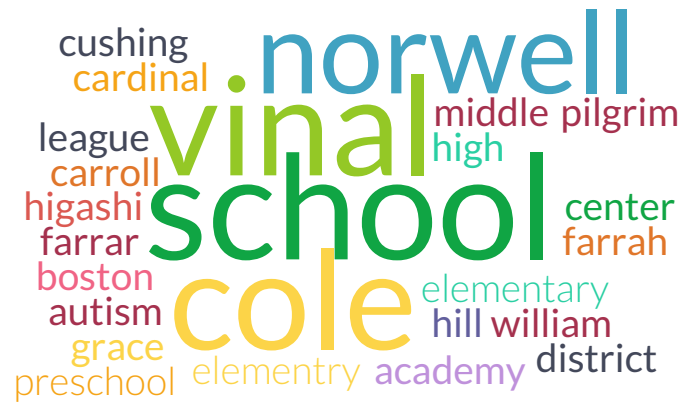
1. How many children in special education do you have?

2. What school does your child attend (optional)?



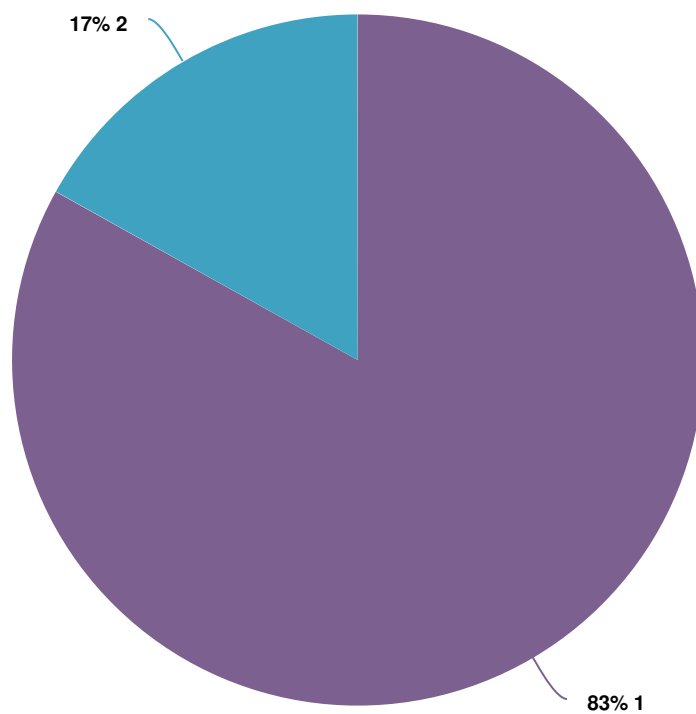
3. What school does the child for whom you are completing this survey attend?

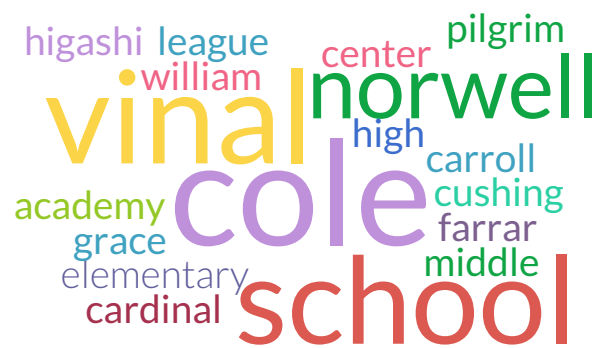

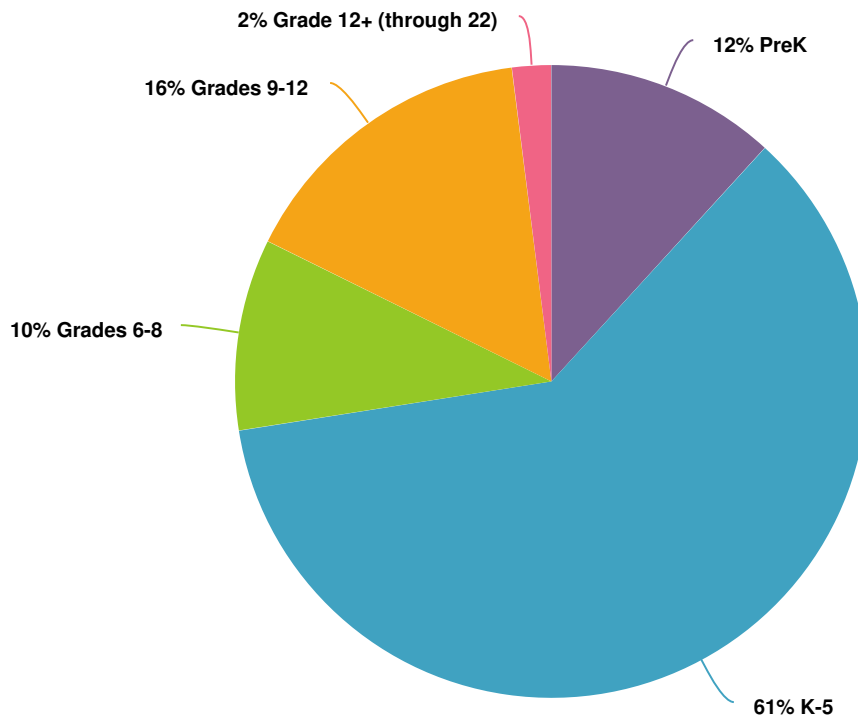
5. What school does your child attend (optional)?

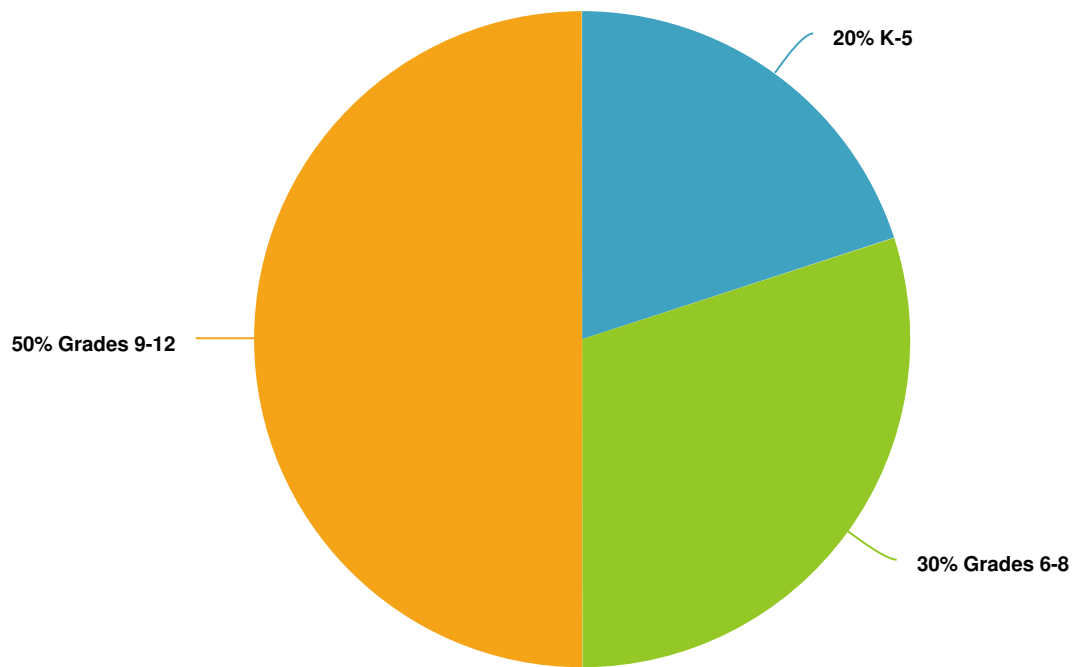

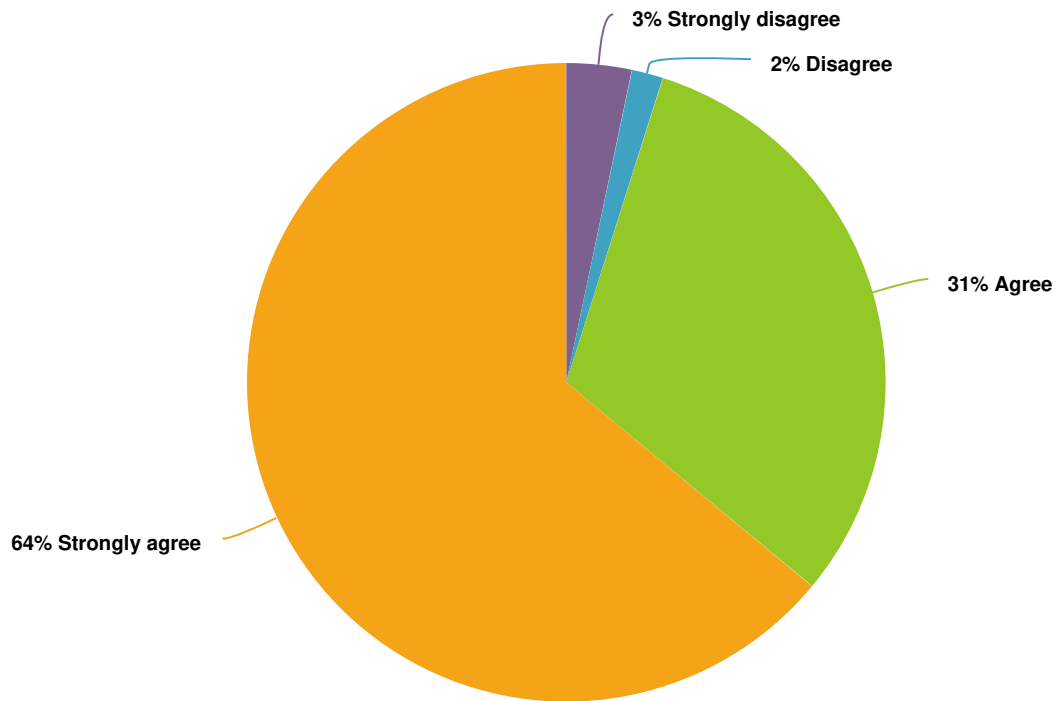

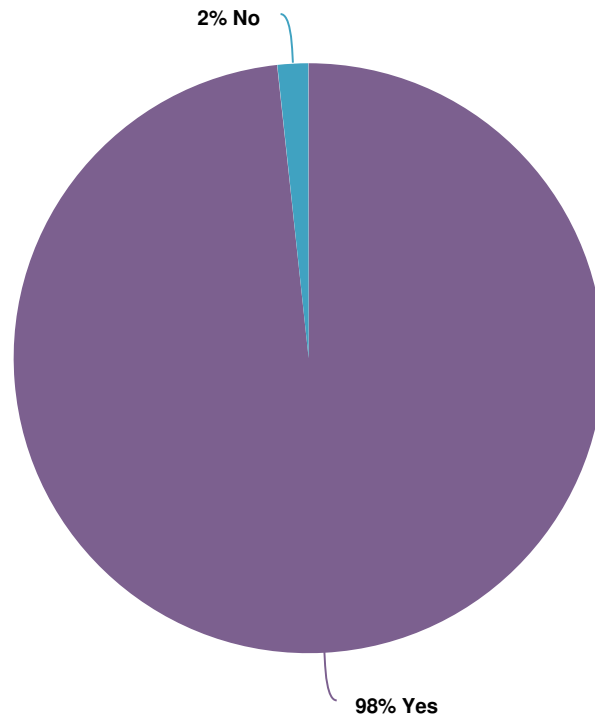

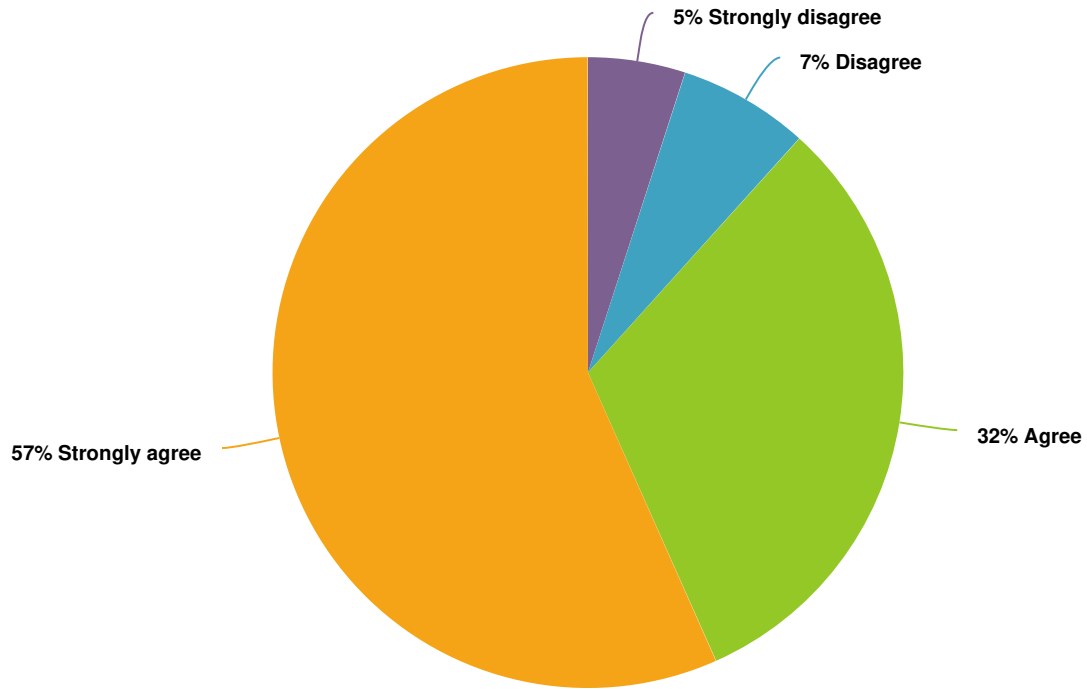

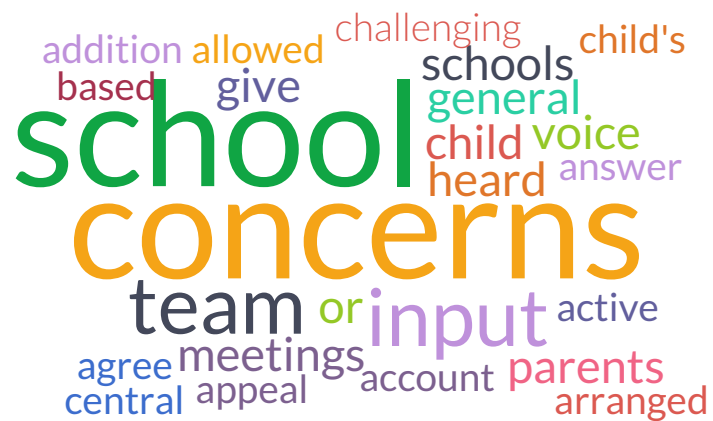

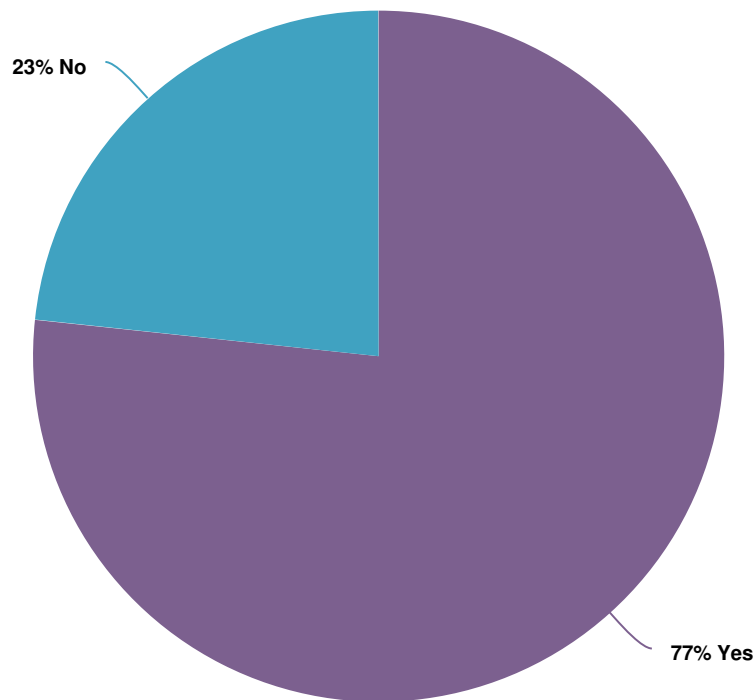

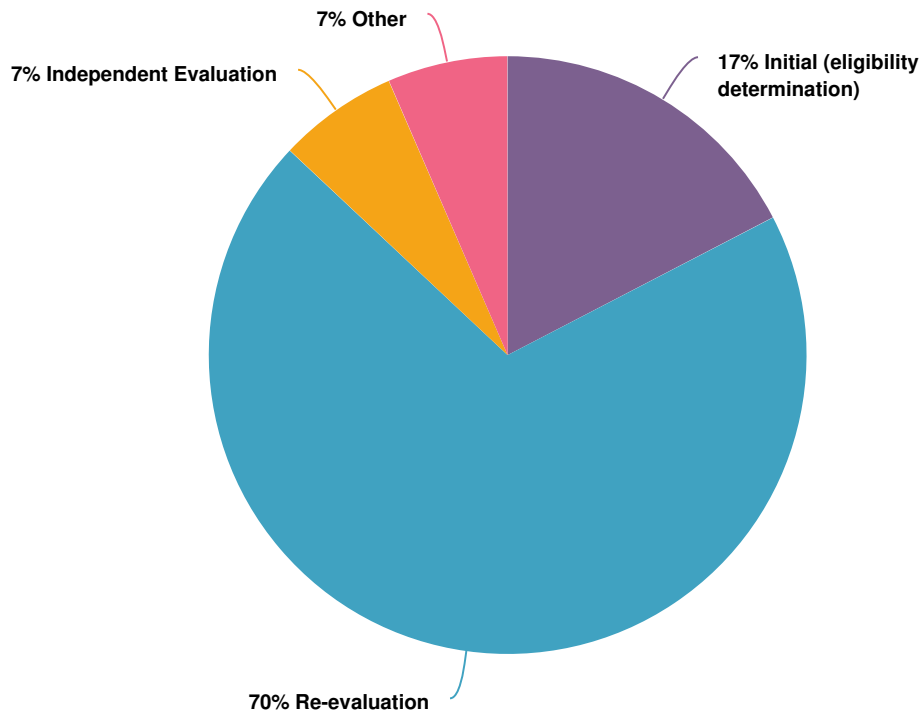
16. Has your child been involved in the special education evaluation process over the past year?

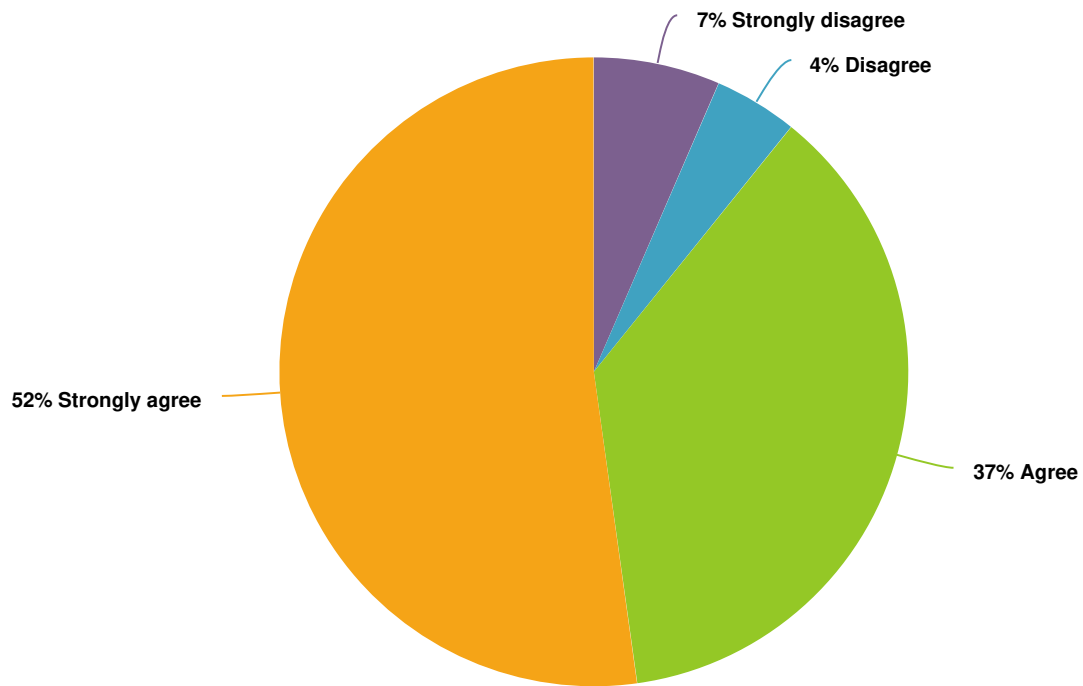

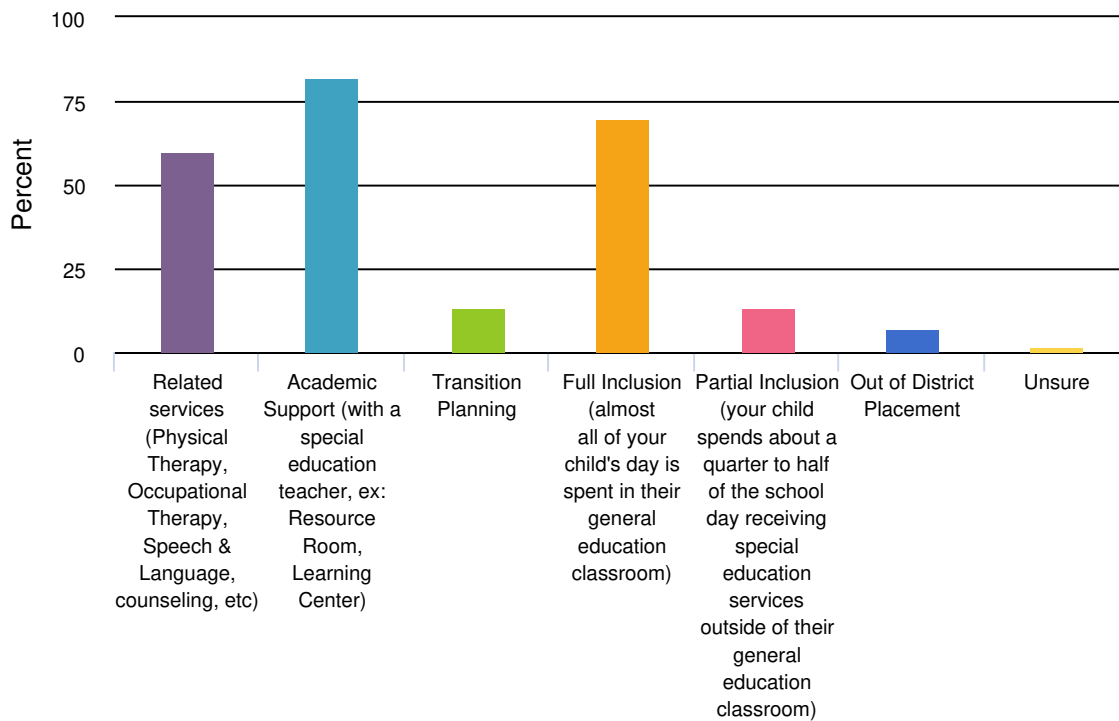

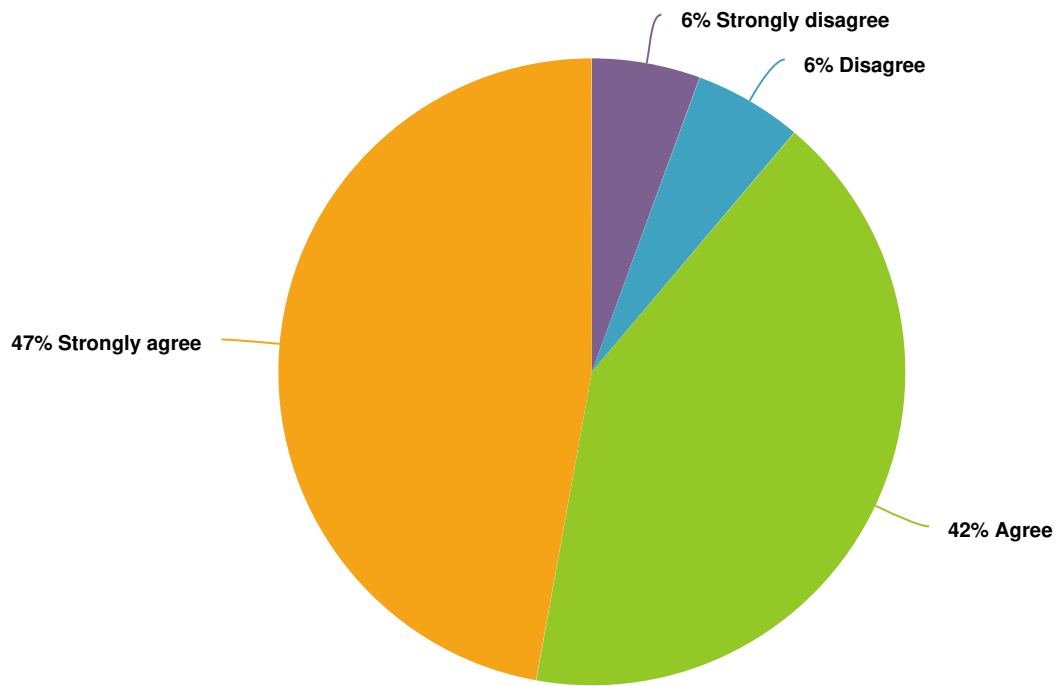

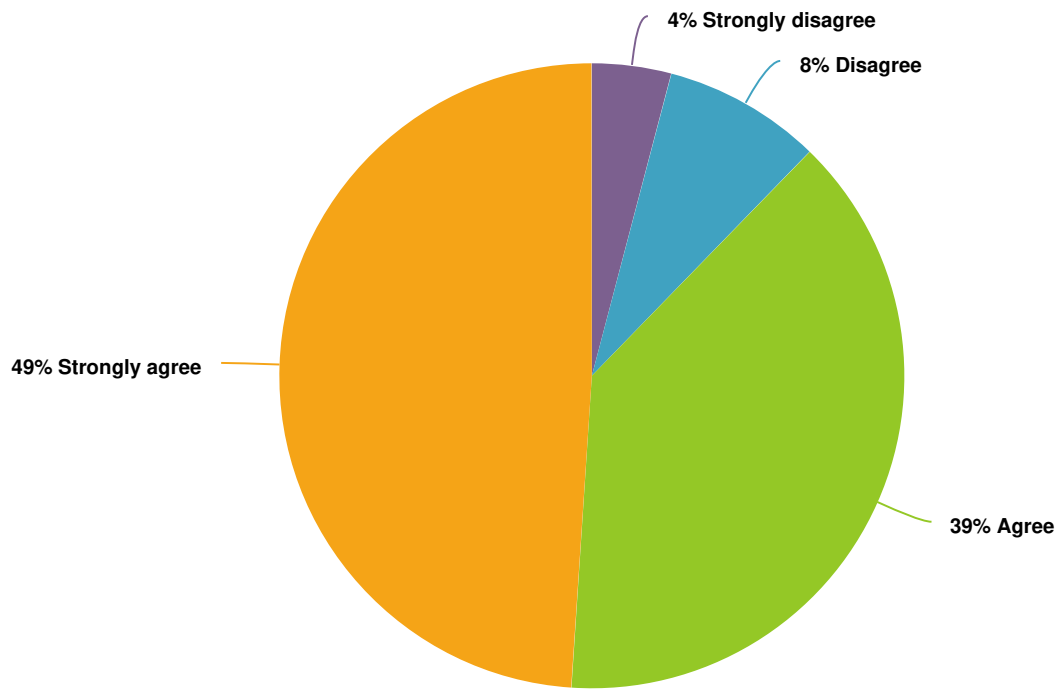

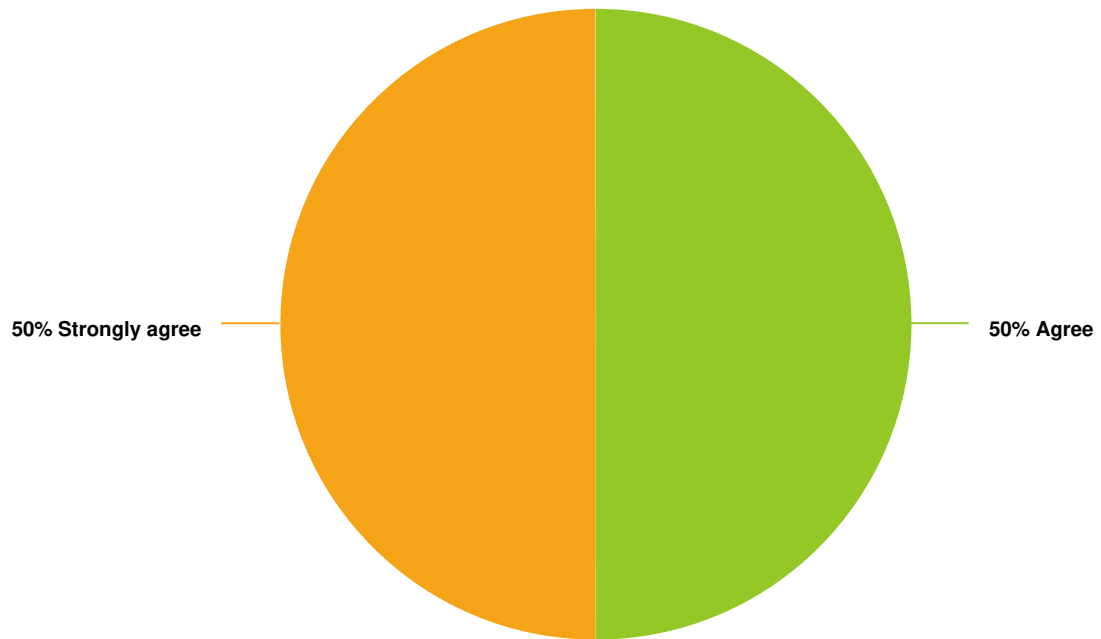

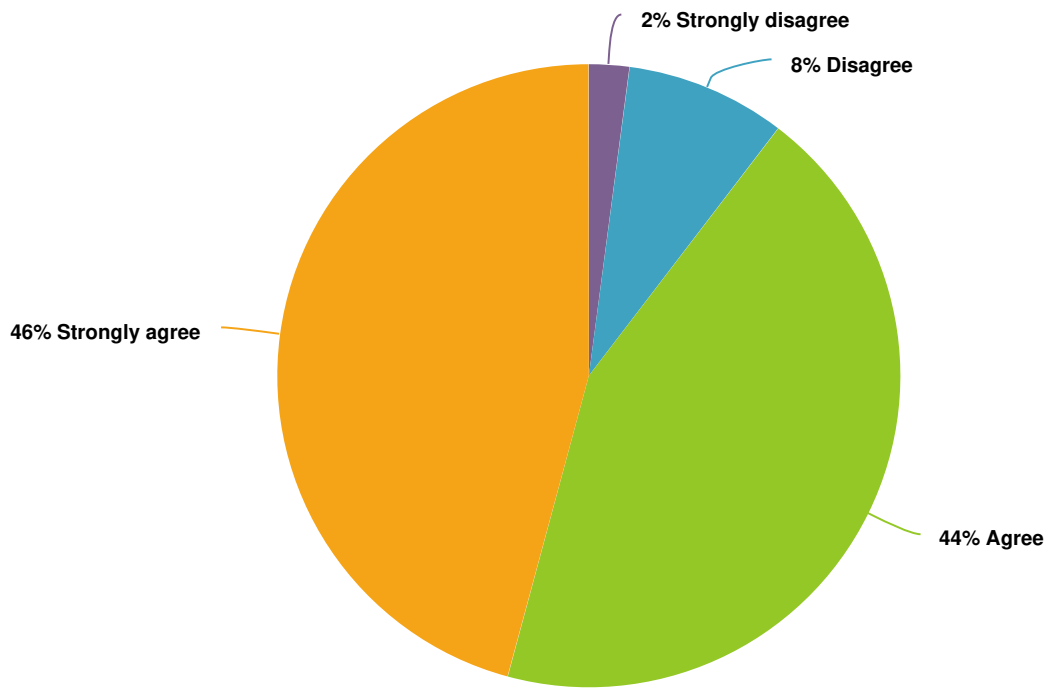

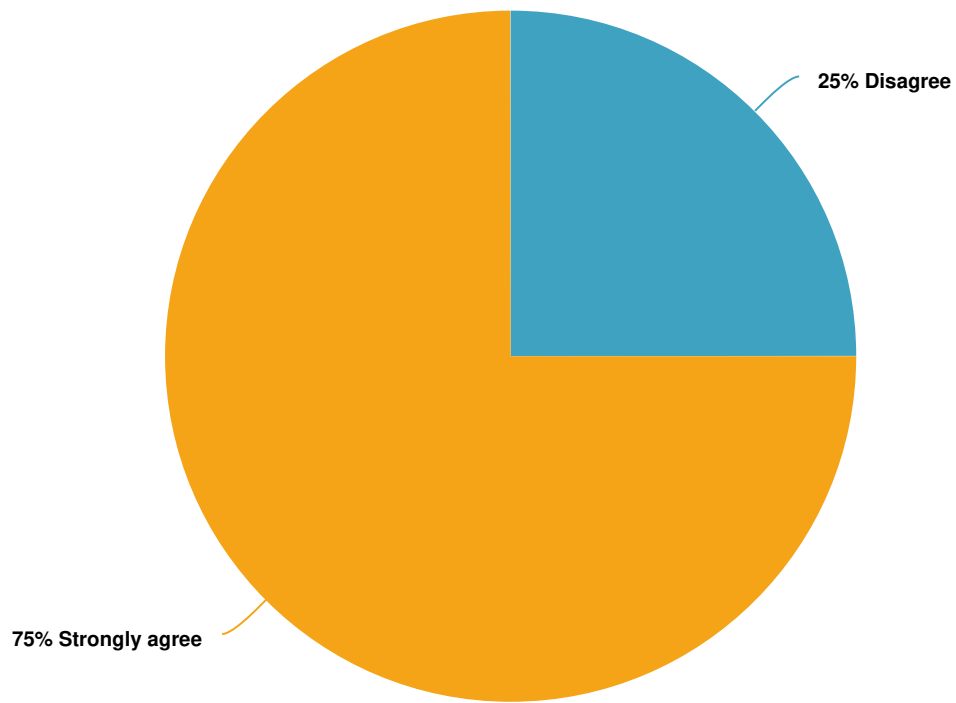

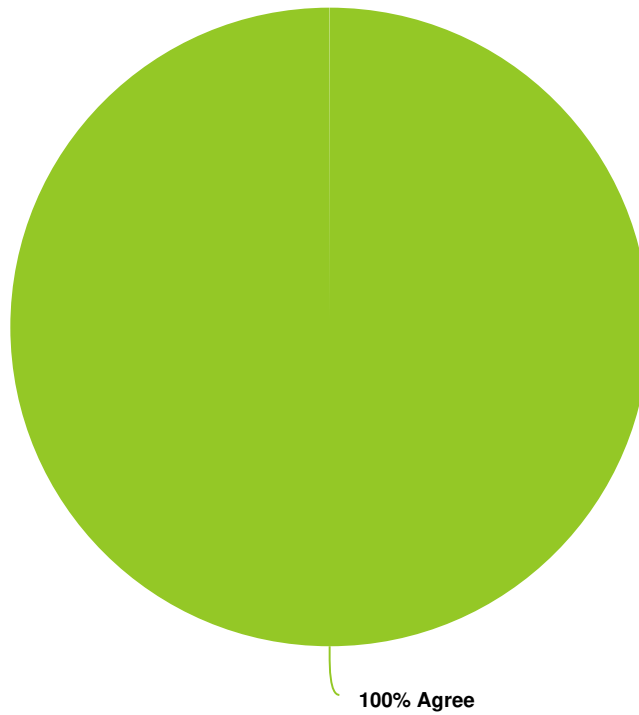

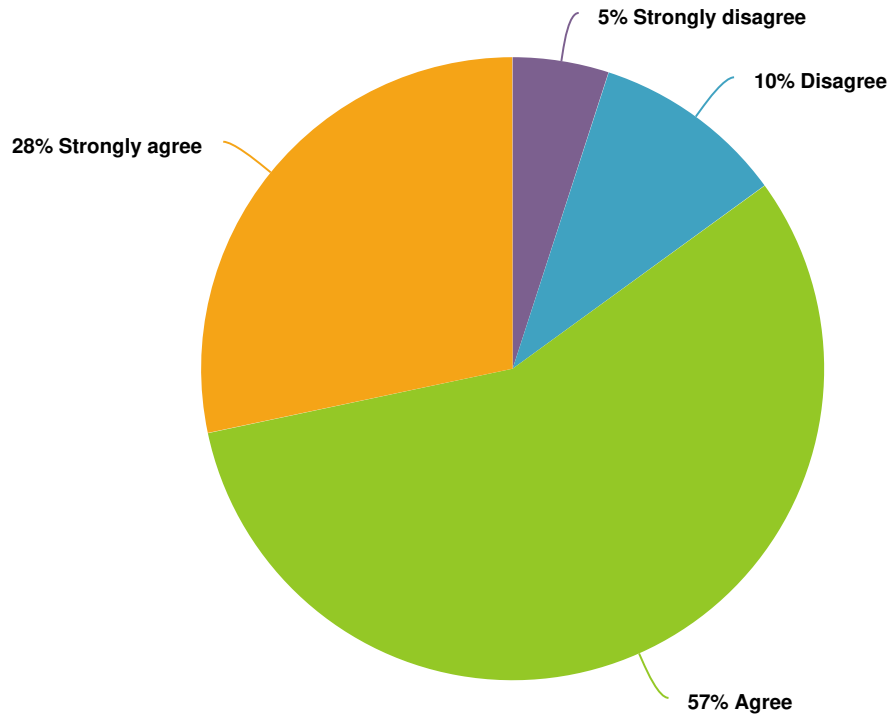

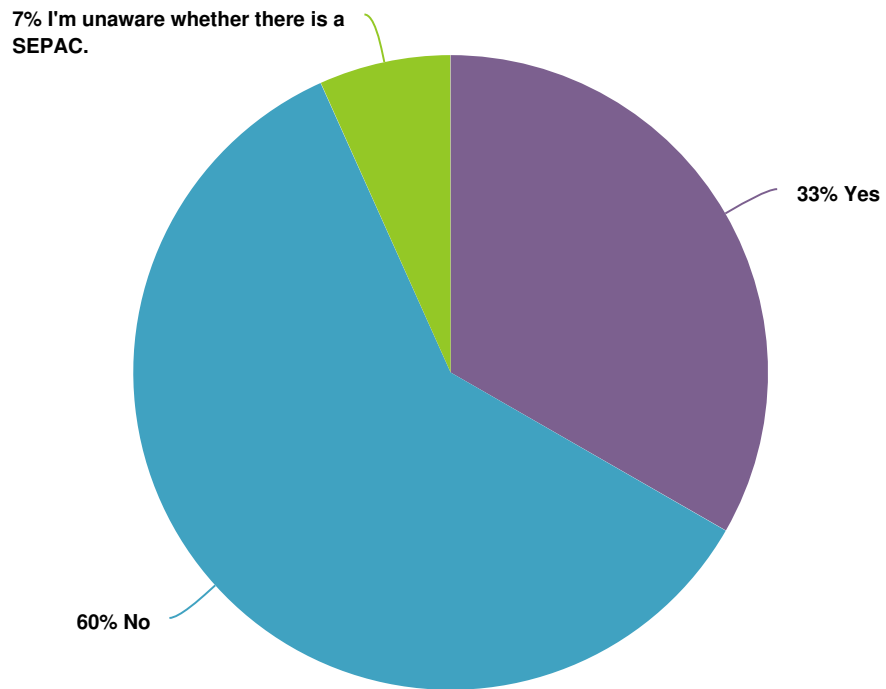

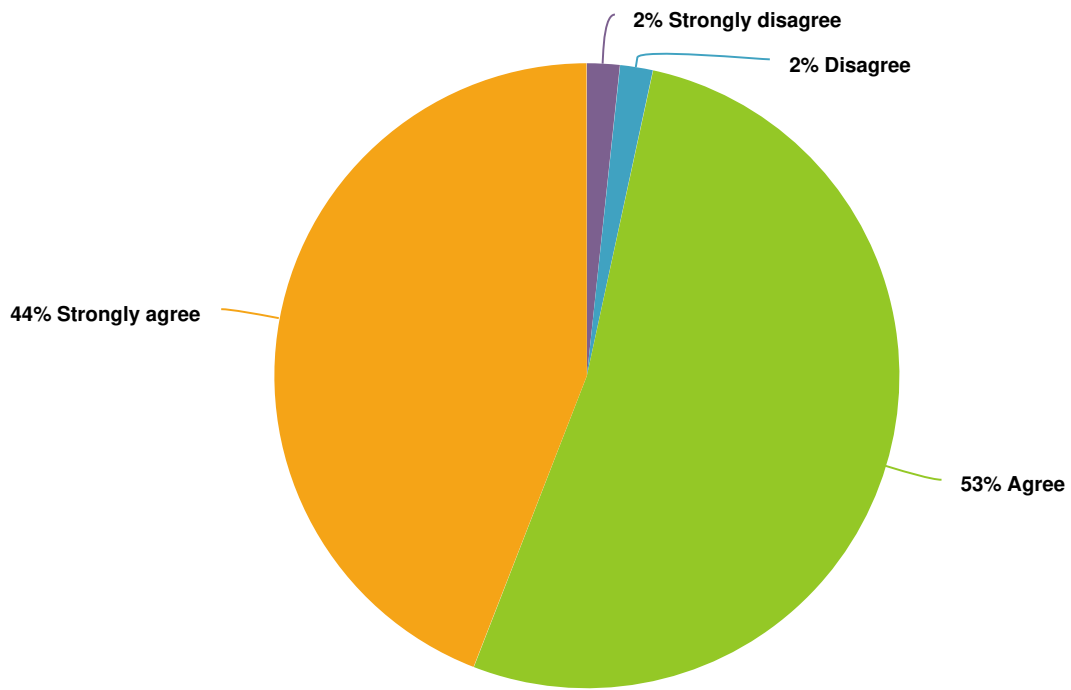

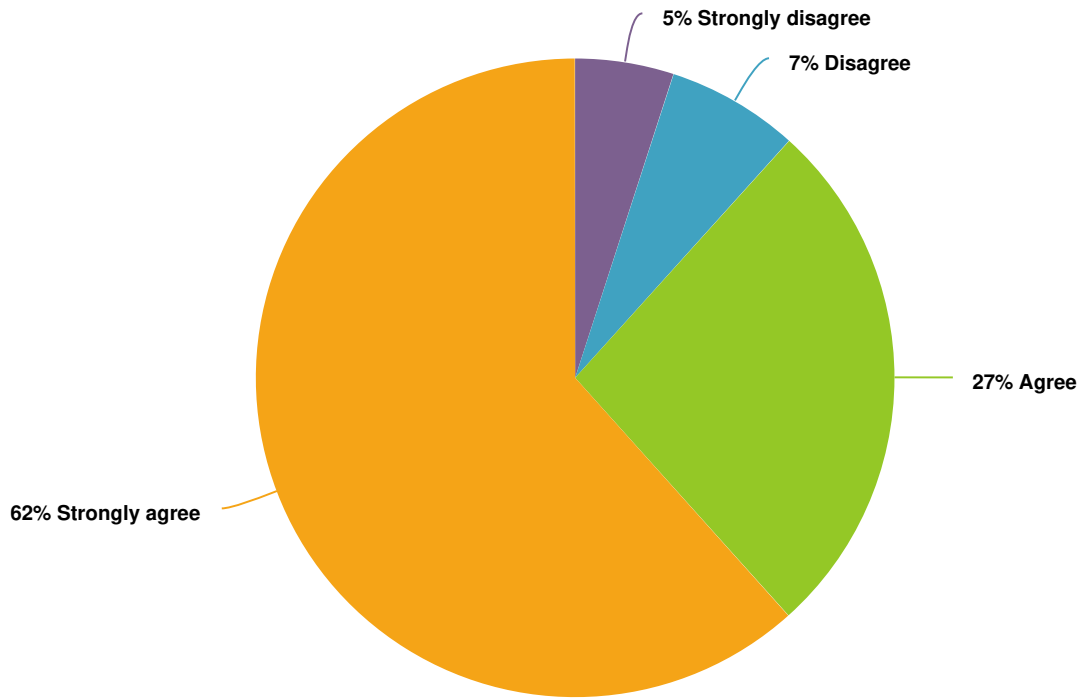

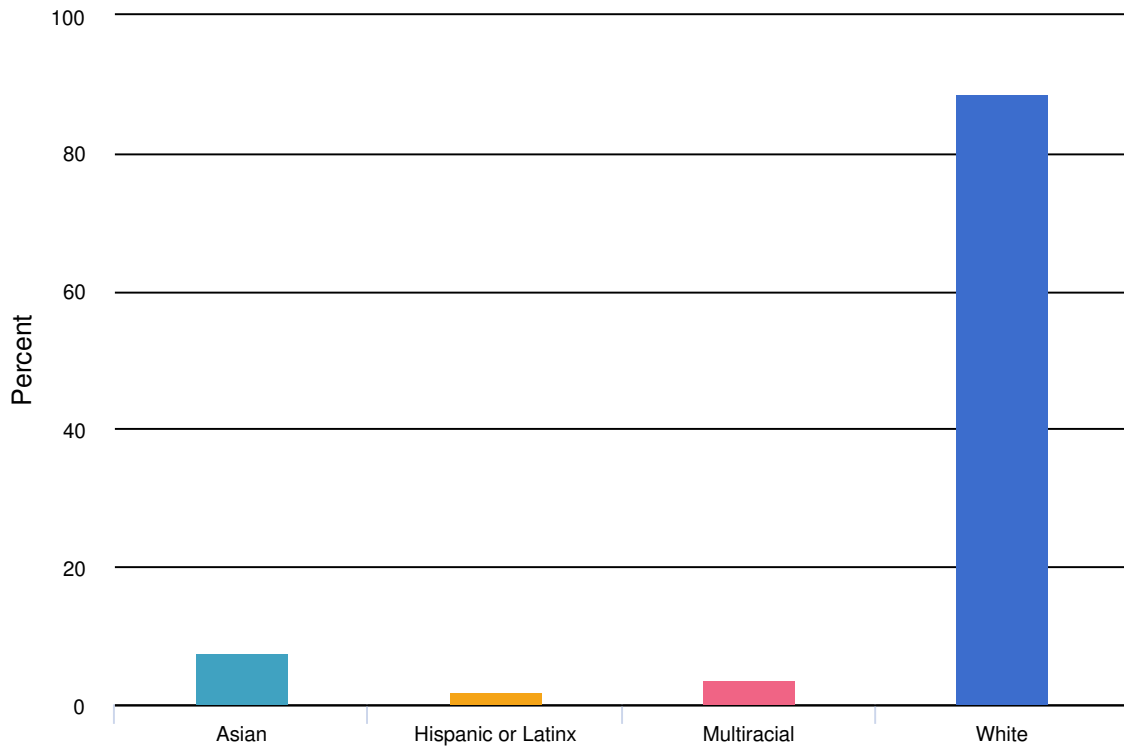
