Nurse's Update

Presently, there are many respiratory and gastrointestinal viruses circulating. Please help keep our school communities as healthy as possible by following these recommendations if your child is not feeling well.

Fever (>100.0° Fahrenheit or higher), nausea, vomiting, diarrhea:

• Stay home until 24 hours after symptoms <u>resolved</u> AND fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication.

If your child has tested positive for COVID, please contact the school nurse for guidance on a return date to school.

• They will need to be out of school for 5 days and return on day 6. A mask is required on days 6-10 if the child has not tested negative in that time frame.


