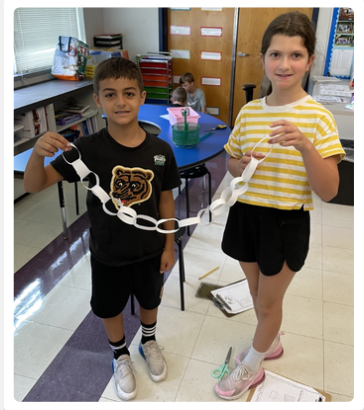

Updates from the Health Office

As we begin to see a few Covid cases starting to pop up I wanted to review the guidance for quarantine:

- To count days for isolation, Day 0 is the first day of symptoms OR the day positive test was taken, whichever is earlier.
- One must isolate out of school for 5 days, returning on day 6, if the student is not negative they must wear a mask from day 6-10 or until a negative test in that window of days.
- Please reach out if your child does test positive and we can confirm the day of return for the student
