UNRAVELReading Comprehension Strategy



USE THESE STRATEGIES WHEN ANSWERING QUESTIONS ABOUT A TEXT.

Underline the title
Number the paragraphs
Read the questions (before reading the passage)
Are important words circled?
Venture through the passage (as in, journey, take it on, dare to explore it)
Eliminate wrong answers
Look back for answers *

- It is very important that each step is taken in the order they are listed.
- Make sure you read the questions before you read the story. This will help you know what information to look for.
- Are important words circled? This would include anything in bold type, italics, etc.
- Eliminate wrong answers means to get rid of the answers that don't make sense, cross them out. Use the No/Maybe/Yes strategy.

*Remember, some answers are not found directly in the text. Then, you need to use your THINGS GOOD READERS DO strategies. In some cases, you may need to PREDICT, CONNECT, QUESTION, INFER in order to accurately answer the reading comprehension question.
