## SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES-*Map Activity*

We all know that Spain speaks Spanish...but what about all of the other countries whose official language is Spanish? During this activity, we will learn where the other Spanish speaking countries are located, what their capital cities are, and what bodies of water are found near them.

### Materials Needed:

pencil  
colored pencils  
black fine point pen (to label map)  
a textbook (in the back of the room)

★ YOU WILL HAVE 2 CLASS PERIODS TO WORK ON THIS!!!

### STEP 1

1. Using a textbook from the bookcase in the back of the classroom, label your maps IN PENCIL with the country names, capital cities, and the bodies of water found on the back of this sheet. Be sure to write in PENCIL!!! (See rubric attached. A LARGE part of your grade is neatness! You need to be sure that all country names, etc. fit neatly on your map! I have provided lots of extra maps in case you would like to map a rough draft before beginning your final draft.)

### STEP 2

1. Label the countries, capital cities, and bodies of water VERY NEATLY with the black fine point pen (Again, I have lots of extra copies of the maps in case you would like to make a rough draft.)

### STEP 3

1. Color your maps with colored pencils.

COLOR CODES:

YELLOW=non-Spanish speaking countries

BLUE=bodies of water

ALL OTHER COLORS=Spanish speaking countries



### STEP 4

1. Be sure to write your name and section on both of your maps.
