Dear Families and Staff,

We have completed our first week and a half of school. Since last Friday, there have been three COVID-19 positive cases: 2 cases at the Vinal School and 1 case at the Cole School. Families are contacted by school nurses, administrators or the Norwell Board of Health Agent Ben Margro or one of the public health nurses regarding positive cases and close contact situations.

The quarantine and safety testing protocols for COVID-19 are posted on the school website under [COVID-19 Resources](#).

The school nurses will confirm when it is appropriate to return to school. We are working hard to understand the impact of the virus on our school community, and this information is a critical piece.

The Norwell Board of Health is aware of the positive cases. As a reminder, if a close contact is identified, parents of students who were in close contact with the community member will be notified privately by school nurses, the Board of Health, or the State Community Tracing Collaborative. We are collaborating with our local board of health to complete contact tracing. Additionally, we are asking those parents whose students are tested for COVID-19 to please report the results to the school nurse.

This week we were able to begin our COVID-19 testing program for both symptomatic students and test and stay for students identified as close contacts due to school exposure. We hope to begin the routine safety testing (pool testing) in the next few weeks. In order to participate in the district's testing programs, you are required to provide consent. The consent portal is run by CIC and can be found by clicking [HERE](#).

On Thursday nights the City and Town Data is updated. On 9/16/21 the Norwell data was updated for the two week period from 8/29/21 - 9/11/21.

- 14-day Average Daily Incident rate = 13.3
- 14-day Percent Positivity = 2.14%
- Case Counts (past 2 weeks) = 20

DESE Positive Case Reporting:

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) began collecting data on the number of COVID-19 positive cases by district for students and staff on Monday, September 13. Reports are released on Thursdays. Here is a [link](#) to their data page.
