Dear Families and Staff,

Since last Friday, there have been five COVID-19 positive cases: 1 case at the High School, 3 cases at the Cole School, and 1 case at the Middle School. Families are contacted by school nurses, administrators or the Norwell Board of Health Agent Ben Margro or one of the public health nurses regarding positive cases and close contact situations.

The quarantine and safety testing protocols for COVID-19 are posted on the school website under [COVID-19 Resources](#).

The school nurses will confirm when it is appropriate to return to school. We are working hard to understand the impact of the virus on our school community, and this information is a critical piece. If you have a close contact concern that occurs over the weekend, please keep your child at home until you have spoken to the school nurse regarding the appropriate protocol.

The Norwell Board of Health is aware of the positive cases. As a reminder, if a close contact is identified, parents of students who were in close contact with the community member will be notified privately by school nurses, the Board of Health, or the State Community Tracing Collaborative. We are collaborating with our local board of health to complete contact tracing. Additionally, we are asking those parents whose students are tested for COVID-19 to please report the results to the school nurse.

Our *Test and Stay* program is up and running which has enabled us to allow 41 students to remain in school instead of quarantining at home. As a reminder, *Test and Stay* is only available to students who have been identified as a close contact due to an in-school exposure. We continue to encourage all families to complete consent for our testing programs using the CIC testing portal which can be found [HERE](#). Students may not participate in these testing programs without parental consent.

The Mass.Gov Dashboard has not been updated because of Veterans Day. The information below is from last week.

On Thursday nights the City and Town Data is updated. On 11/4/21 the Norwell data was updated for the two week period from 10/17/21 - 10/30/21.

- 14-day Average Daily Incident rate = 10.7
- 14-day Percent Positivity = 1.79%
- Case Counts (past 2 weeks) = 16

DESE Positive Case Reporting:

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) began collecting data on the number of COVID-19 positive cases by district for students and staff on Monday, September 13. Reports are released on Thursdays. Here is a [link](#) to their data page.
