

The following language regarding mask regulations has been added to the Student-Parent Handbooks under Health Services section.

In accordance with the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education Commissioner Riley's universal mask mandate for PK - 12 students in Massachusetts public schools, all students are required to wear masks on busses and while indoors during the school day and while attending school sponsored activities except during lunch when eating. Students who do not comply with this requirement will meet with the building Principal and parents to discuss whether the student is in a condition to attend school in a manner that is safe for the student and others in the building, and may be subject to progressive discipline for deliberate non-compliance. Requests for exemptions will be considered based on the existence of a documented medical endangerment presented by masking, subject to further review by the School Physician, or documented behavior factors which interfere with a student's ability to comply.
